I will offer thanks to the LORD.

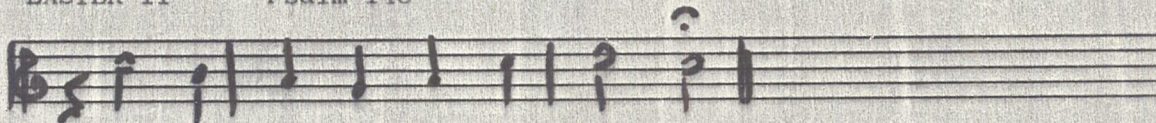
