

HOW TO COMPUTE YOUR GPA

Follow these steps:

1. Convert each grade earned to the equivalent value in Quality points. Use the following table to **multiply the number of Semester Hours by Quality Points awarded:**

<u>Quality Points</u>		<u>Letter Grade</u>	
4.0	for an	A	Excellent
3.67	for an	A-	
3.33	for a	B+	
3.0	for a	B	Good
2.67	for a	B-	
2.33	for a	C+	
2.0	for a	C	Fair
1.67	for a	C-	
1.0	for a	D	Poor, but passing
.67	for a	D-	
0	for a	F	Failure

This will give you the total Quality Points for each course.

2. **Add up all the Quality Points** for the semester
3. **Divide** the total amount of Quality Points by the total number of GPA Hours.
4. This is your Grade Point Average (GPA) for the semester.
5. Follow the same process for the next semesters to create a cumulative GPA for the entire year.
