

FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE HELPFUL HINTS AND GUIDES

To alleviate some frustration with trying to figure out the Final Exam Schedule, please read the following instructions for some helpful hints and guides for finding your exam times.

For example, a student might have the following schedule:

HIS 2200 (2319) History of the American People, TR 1130-1245
HUM 1970 (2326) Arts and Ideas, MWF 3-350
PES 1000 (2527) Fitness & Wellness for Life, R 7 – 840pm
POS 1100 (2553) American Government/Politics, MWF 8-850
EDU 2020 (3170) Principles & Technology in Ed, WF 1-150

Only those courses that do **not** fall into the normal course schedule times (listed below) will be written out as additional courses on the schedule. All courses that fall into the normal course time follow the general schedule as listed on the final exam schedule.

'Normal' course times are as follows -

MWF 8-850, 9-950, 10-1050, 1-150, 2-250, 3-350
TR 8-915, 930-1045, 1130-1245, 1-215, 230-345

Using the example student's schedule above, then one can easily find the final exam times for HIS 2200, HUM 1970, POS 1100, and IDS 1970 using the final exam schedule.

HIS 2200's final exam would be Tuesday, December 8th at 10:30 because all courses that meet on TR from 1130-1245 have a final exam at 10:30 on Tuesday, December 8th.

HUM 1970's final exam would be Friday, December 11th at 1:00 because all courses that meet on MWF from 3-350 have a final exam at 1:00 on Friday, December 11th.

Using the same logic, POS 1100 would have a final exam at 8am on Wed, Dec 9th.

The tricky part comes in when courses do **not** fall into the normal course schedule. Using this example student's schedule, we need to find the final exam times for PES 1000 (2527) and EDU 2020 (3170).

PES 1000 meets during the evening on Thursdays. For this course, look at the final page of the final exam schedule for the Evening Classes. Because this course meets at 7pm on Thursdays, the final exam would be Thursday, Dec 10th at 7pm.

EDU 2020 meets only Wednesdays and Fridays at 1:00. One can guess from the schedule that this final will more than likely meet with the rest of the MWF 1:00 courses, but to check, look at the MWF 1-150 course time final exam slot on the schedule (Wed 12/9 at 10:30). If you look at the additional course list, you will find EDU 2020 (3170) included. The "(3170)" is the **Course Registration Number** for that specific section of the course. If you are unsure of your **CRN** for your section of a course, you can find it by looking at your course schedule via Banner Self-Service. The **CRN** is listed on both the Student Detail Schedule and the Week at a Glance Schedule. It is a 4-digit number that starts with either a "2" or "3" for the fall semester.

As long as you have no conflicts in your everyday course schedule, you should have no conflicts in your final exam schedule. If you have further questions, please contact the Registrar's Office at Pamela.Borgers@CUChicago.edu.
