A special circumstance can be considered if you/your spouse or your parent (if dependent) anticipates that their future income will be substantially less than what was earned and reported in 2022 on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This can occur when the student or a family member loses employment or other benefits such as child support, when a spouse or parent dies, or when the student or student's parents divorce. Additional expenses such as private tuition or medical expenses may also be considered if it substantially reduces the yearly income. Step 3: Required Documentation------

You must attach a statement explaining the circumstances, in addition to the following supporting documentation or it will not be processed:

- If unemployed:
 - 1. A letter from the former employer stating last date of employment and the total that was earned for the current calendar year (you may also provide a last pay stub as long as the dates match).
 - 2. A copy of the letter from the unemployment office showing eligible benefits.
 - 3. A copy of the unemployed person's 2023 Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required or W-2 forms, if you are applying for a special circumstance for changes based on calendar year 2023.
- If divorce or death occurred:
 - 1. A copy of the divorced or deceased person's 2023 W-2 form(s) and a 2023 Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required.
 - 2. A copy of the divorce decree or death certificate.
- If benefits such as child support has been lost:
 - 1. A copy of the 2023 W-2 form(s) and a Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required, of the person who lost the benefit.
 - 2. A statement from the agency that provided the benefit, stating the date the benefit expired and total received in 2023 or 2024.
- If you paid for private child care and/or private elementary or secondary tuition in excess of 3% of your or your parent's (if dependent) gross in 2022 or 2023 income:
 - 1. Copies of tuition statements for the corresponding 2022 or 2023 calendar year.
 - 2. A copy of the 2023 Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required.
- If you paid medical expenses that will not be covered by insurance or itemized on your tax return, in excess of 11% of your or your parent's (if dependent) gross 2022 or 2023 income:
 - 1. Copies of medical statements, showing payments made in 2022 or 2023, or copies of canceled checks used for payment.
 - 2. A copy of the person's 2022 or 2023 Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required.
- If your special circumstance has not been identified above, please submit the following:
 - 1. All applicable documentation regarding the special circumstance.
 - 2. 2023 W-2 form(s) and a Federal Income Tax Return transcript may be required.
