

Lutheran Servant Award

Fall 2023 – Spring 2024 Office of Financial Aid

Students who were initially awarded the Lutheran Servant Award as an incoming student are required to submit this form in order to renew their award for the 2023-2024 academic year. In order to be eligible for this award, all of the following criteria must continue to be met:

- Full-time, degree-seeking student. Students may enroll in any program of study. This award is not restricted to students pursuing full-time professional church work.
- Parent, step-parent or legal guardian must be a full-time, salaried worker for a Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod congregation, school, agency or any other qualifying LCMS institution. Eligible workers include, but are not limited to, administrative, clerical, custodial, food service staff, administrators, pastors, and teachers.
- The "LCMS Full-time Employment Verification" form must be signed by an appropriate institutional administrator (principal, pastor, Director for Human Resources), and must be returned to the Office of Financial Aid.
- The Lutheran Servant Award is renewable for a maximum of 4 years (beginning from the first year it was awarded) for a maximum total of \$2,000 (\$500 x 4 years) provided that the student remains enrolled full-time and the "LCMS Full-time Employment Verification" form is resubmitted annually.
