Concordia University Chicago is committed to the preparation of students for service to the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod. Students who major in a church work vocation may be awarded tuition assistance with a four-year, renewable Church Professional Grant.

This form must be completed by you and your pastor to receive the Church Professional Grant. The grant is available for up to four years of your undergraduate program as a professional church work major provided that you remain enrolled full-time and this Verification of Professional Church Work Status form must be resubmitted annually. This grant has a cumulative GPA requirement that is monitored each semester for the four years of your undergraduate program. If you change your major and no longer plan to pursue a church professional field, you must contact the Office of Financial Aid at (708) 209-3113. This form must be submitted no later than October 1, 2026.
