Undergraduate Final Exam Information

- Final Exam schedule is for UNDERGRADUATE 16-week and 2nd 8-week classes. Classes that occur in the first 8-week term of the fall or spring term should have their final exam on the last day of their regularly scheduled class periods.
- Exam times are scheduled based on the regular meeting time of the class with the exception for the Method Block courses.
- Final exams are held in the classroom in which the course regularly meets unless otherwise arranged with or by the Office of the Registrar. Subject to change, please check with your instructor.
- Natural Science courses (Biology, Chemistry, and Physics) with separate lecture and lab times should attend the exam time per the **lecture** instead of the lab.
- If a non-Science class has two different weekly meeting times, the exam time is based on the time of the first day of the week the class meets.
- Changes to the Final Exam schedule must be approved by the Office of the Registrar.

It is the student's responsibility to review the undergraduate final exam schedule for 16-week or 2nd 8-week, face-to-face courses prior to the fall and spring semesters per the academic calendar. If the student notes a time conflict for their scheduled final exams, the student should provide their class schedule and work with their faculty prior to the final exam week to determine and agree upon an alternate time during the final exam week. If no arrangement can be agreed upon between the student and the faculty, the student should email their student ID (H number) and any final exam time conflict communication with their faculty to Registrar@cuchicago.edu for assistance.
