This month we are proud to spotlight **Emily Woock BA '08**, an alum whose journey exemplifies the lasting and impactful influence of a CUC education. Graduating from the <u>Director of</u> <u>Parish Music Program</u>. with a piano pedagogy certification, she discusses how CUC equipped her for a life in service to Christ and His church.

Her postgraduate journey took an unexpected turn during Lectures in Church Music in 2007, where encounters with influential musicians Dr. Craig Cramer and Dr. John Feierabend altered her trajectory. Encouragement from CUC professors Dr. Steve Wente and Jonathan Kohrs led her to pursue a Master of Sacred Music at the University of Notre Dame where Dr. Cramer taught, followed by a Master of Music Education at Anderson University where Dr. Feierabend taught.

During her studies, Woock accepted a call to Redeemer Elmhurst, where Concordia-Chicago's former president Rev. Dr. Daniel L. Gard was also a member. Dr. Gard encouraged her to consider a doctorate and "brought it up any chance he had." After lots of prayer and reflection, she applied to Indiana University for her doctorate and was accepted.

After completing her coursework, she was asked to teach as an adjunct professor of music here at Concordia. Reflecting back on a summer certification course she taught, Woock states, "Talk about a full circle moment! Here I was, a Teacher Trainer with the Feierabend Association of Music Education teaching my very first certification course in the chapel..... *the very place I had first met Dr. Feierabend back in 2007*! I could not stop reflecting on the many ways the Lord had blessed me through CUC and how so much of my life all connects back to my time as a student here."

Woock is now an Instructor of Music and the Principal Organist & Worship Music Director here at Concordia, a position that "feels

like home" to her.

"I love working alongside my mentors who gave so much to me when I was a student here. Taking this position felt like coming home, and I hope I can in some small way give back to the place that gave me so much in my formative years." Woock ultimately credits her career to how Christ worked through others at Concordia to encourage her to follow her calling.

"I learned just as much about life and serving the church outside of class as I did in class. I have been blessed with many educational opportunities and wonderful professors along the way, but CUC stands out. It's special. Students and professors learn from each other, attend chapel together, share meals together, and professors do not just vanish after graduation but continue to be there to support and encourage. The CUC experience is invaluable because of the people, and for that I will always be grateful."
