Ralph Munger, class of 1974

This month's spotlight features **Ralph Munger, BA '74** who continues to cheer on CUC and Stand Tall for Excellence, Community, and Faith.

A few weeks ago, we celebrated our very own <u>Coach Chase Hankins</u> on securing his first win as head coach of Concordia University Chicago Football. But what made this moment even more special was the heartfelt encouragement he received from his former high school football coach and CURF legend, **Ralph Munger, BA '74.**

In a heartfelt show of support for his former player, Munger- through his wife Kathy (also a proud CUC alumna!)- sent his congratulations to Coach Hankins for this milestone achievement with the photo above.

Ralph Munger is not only a fellow Concordia alum but also a member of the university's Athletic Hall of Fame, being inducted in 2003. During his time at CUC, Munger was named an All-NAIA All-District Running Back, the Cougars' Most Valuable Player in 1974, and was also recognized among the All-Lutheran Outstanding College Athletes of America in 1973.

Coach Munger went on to be one of the most-winning high school football coaches in Michigan history, with the stadium at Rockford High School (MI) named in his honor. The teams he coached (Frankenmuth High School & Rockford High School) have combined

for 13 playoff appearances, 14 conference championships, six regional titles, two district championships and one state championship appearance. *Munger is also a ten-time Regional Coach of the Year as selected by the Michigan High School Football Coaches Association.*

Coach Munger truly Stands Tall for Excellence—cheering on the next generation, offering support, and staying connected to what's happening here at CUC. This connection between two generations of CUC football demonstrates how we Stand Tall for community, uplifting one another as Christ does for us.


Beer and Brats Homecoming Tailgate
