Age Requirement 3-5 years old

Our year round Full Day Preschool program offers project-based learning and engages children in real-life experiences inspired by their interests. Our highly qualified teachers provide a solid educational foundation with a balance of guided and free play to support children's natural drive for learning. Our SCALE Curriculum supports spiritual, social-emotional, communication, physical and cognitive skills.

SCALE Curriculum:

Spiritual and Social-Emotional Learning

Our nurturing, Christian environment fosters the development of social-emotional skills necessary for academic success and lifelong learning.

Children learn negotiation, conflict-resolution, and self-regulation skills through daily choices and respectful interactions with peers and teachers.

Communication for Learning

Teachers engage children in meaningful conversations to build vocabulary and ask stimulating questions to obtain information and develop critical thinking.

Children develop literacy skills through book reading, phonological awareness, singing and writing opportunities in a language rich environment.

Artistic Endeavors in Learning

Children express their knowledge and rep-

resent ideas using a variety of art media, music, drama and construction materials.

Teachers provide open-ended environments, materials and ample time to encourage imaginative play, creative expression and problem-solving skills.

Lifestyle and Learning

Children learn to make healthy food choices, practice autonomy and master self-help skills.

Teachers engage children in free and structured physical activities to develop flexibility, strength, and coordination of large and small muscles.

Exploration and Learning

Children participate in projects and use tools and technology (e.g., magnifiers, scales, light tables) to find answers to their questions.

Hands-on mathematical and scientific experiences promote critical thinking, problem-solving, decision making and investigation skills.
