Age Requirement 6 weeks to 15 months

SCALE Curriculum:

Spiritual and Social-Emotional Learning

Teachers model caring and trusting relationships in a nurturing, Christian environment.

Children develop feelings of security and a positive self-concept.

Communication for Learning

Children learn listening and speaking skills through daily interactions with teachers.

Early literacy is developed through picture books, rhyming games and songs.

Artistic Endeavors in Learning

Children use their senses to experience art materials.

Teachers encourage imitation and exploration of sound and music.

Lifestyle and Learning

Teachers select materials to promote motor development, hand-eye coordination and visual tracking.

Children learn personal hygiene habits and self-help skills.

Exploration and Learning

Environment rich in sensory and natural materials promotes free play and discovery.

Children independently explore differences in texture, size and number; experiment with cause and effect and spatial relations.
