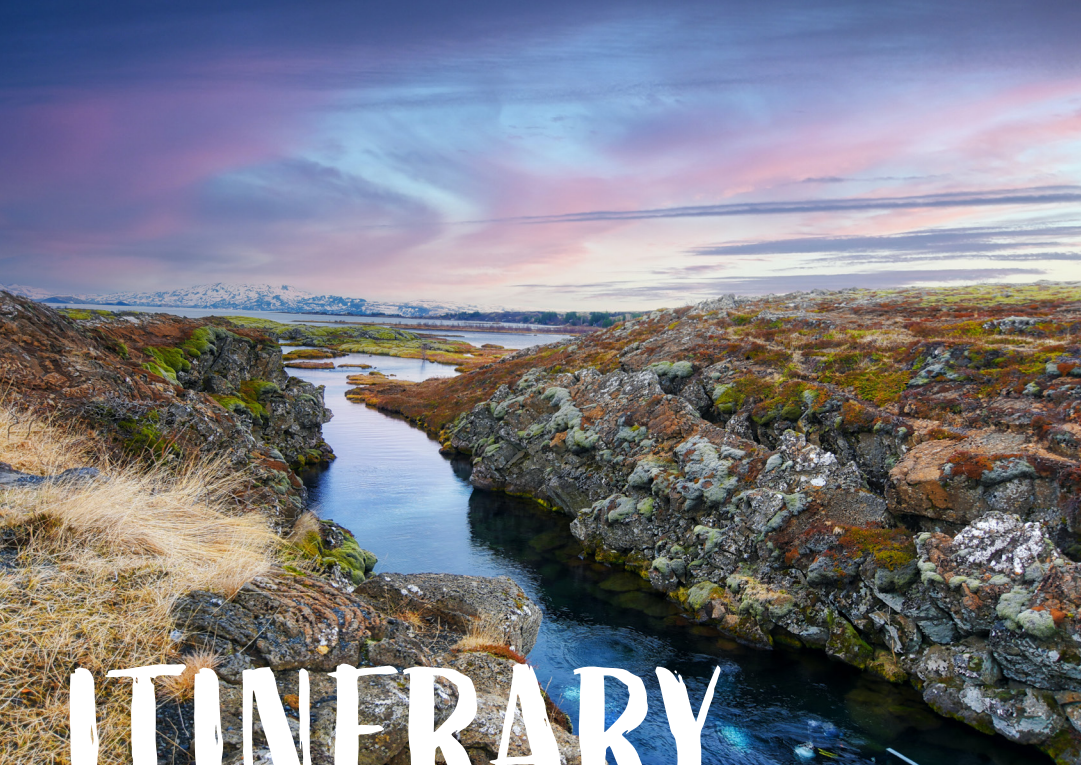
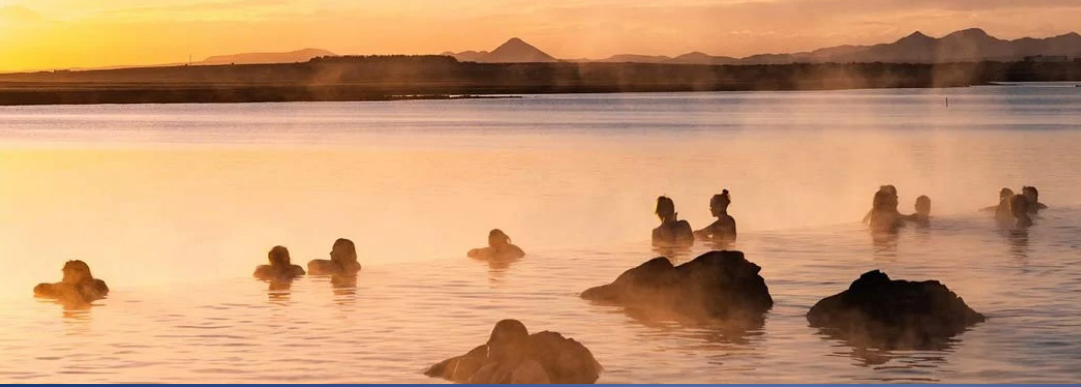

ITINERARY

DAY 1 WEDNESDAY, JULY 14, 2027 DEPART HOME

Depart on your overnight flight to Reykjavik, Iceland.

DAY 2 THURSDAY, JULY 15, 2027 REYKJAVIK

Arrive in Reykjavik early in the morning. Transfer to your hotel where you will be able to check your bags with the bellman. An optional excursion is offered this morning to visit the Sky Lagoon for some thermal spa relaxation and rejuvenation (additional cost). This is a great way to relax and rejuvenate after your flight and before your adventure begins. In the afternoon, return to your hotel for check in. This evening will include a group welcome dinner.

DAY 3 FRIDAY, JULY 16, 2027 REYKJAVIK

This morning you will have breakfast included at the hotel. Then depart for your first day of adventure as you travel to Þingvellir which is situated on the northern shore of Lake Þingvallavatn, the largest natural lake in Iceland. Þingvellir is a remarkable geological phenomenon and the most important historical site in Iceland. It is the site of the world's oldest parliament founded in the year 930 AD by the settlers of Iceland. The beautiful Almannagjá canyon that runs through the park is a boundary meeting of two of the earth's tectonic plates and the combination of both natural wonder and historical significance makes it inseparable from the fabric of Icelandic national life. Continue to the Geysir geothermal area. The spouting hot spring Geysir was claimed to be the biggest one in the world. The old Geysir has been mostly dormant for decades, but when it was active, its eruptions reached the height of at least 80 meters (262 feet). There are spouting hot springs all around the area, such as the ever-lively Strokkur, which erupts every three to five minutes.



Gullfoss, the “Golden Waterfall” is the most famous of the country’s many waterfalls. Here the river Hvítá drops 96 feet in two falls, creating an awesome spectacle. Witness thousands of tons of icy water thunder majestically down in a double-fall into a deep gorge. There is a certain rawness, power, and vastness to Gullfoss which leaves most people who visit feeling quite humble in the face of the raw power of nature. Lunch is included today. This evening you are free to explore Reykjavik and dine on your own.

DAY 4 SATURDAY, JULY 17, 2027
REYKJAVIK

Embark: Depart at 7:00PM

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing for a special adventure. Enjoy a three-hour cruise to experience the magic of Faxaflói Bay, whether it is whale watching or bird watching, sea angling or just a cruise enjoying the beautiful environment of the Bay of Reykjavík. Reykjavík is very close to some of

the best whale watching grounds in the country. In less than an hour you will be in a prime spot to catch a glimpse of a number of species of whales including humpbacks, minke whales, pilot whales and a few species of dolphins.

After your adventure you will transfer to your Celebrity cruise ship where you can enjoy lunch and settle in before your sailing departure this evening.

Seydisfjörður is an eclectic little town, tucked away at the end of a deep fjord in the east of Iceland. Surrounded by volcanoes, waterfalls, and in summer, green fields dotted with purple lupins, this former hub for herring fishing is a favorite stop on cruises to Iceland. On a cruise to Seydisfjörður, walk alongside colorful wooden homes and the famous rainbow-painted street leading to the pretty blue church as you enjoy the fresh, crisp air. Immerse yourself in Icelandic art culture, and celebrate Seydisfjörður's rich history as a creative community. Venture through incredible natural surroundings as you trek to the cascading Gufufoss waterfalls, and wander along the shore looking out for seals and porpoises before continuing on your Iceland cruise.

DAY 7 TUESDAY, JULY 20, 2027
AKUREYRI

Docked: 8:00AM to 8:00PM

Akureyri is Iceland's second-largest city and one of the country's most important ports and fishing centers. Affectionately known as the Capital of North Iceland, it has a cool café scene, a growing gourmet movement, and a bustling nightlife that proves this city is more than meets the eye. From fabulous summer festivals fueled by the Midnight Sun, like the Akureyri Summer Arts festival (late June-late August), to some of the best skiing this side of the arctic circle, Akureyri is a laid-back Nordic city and a study in contrasts.

Soar into the blue sky to discover Grimsey Island, home to only 92 residents and thousands of sea birds. The city's Botanical Gardens is famed for its collection of high-latitude plants and well worth a visit. Explore the ancient lava formations of Dimmuborgir and the geothermal landscape of bubbling mud and hissing fumaroles at Namafjall Mountain.



The city is best known as the gateway to Iceland’s natural wonders – thundering waterfalls, gurgling lava fields, snow-capped mountains, sweeping fjords, and robust folk culture. Whatever you choose, it’s sure to be the adventure of a lifetime.

DAY 8 WEDNESDAY, JULY 21, 2027
ISAFJORDUR

Tendered: 8:00AM to 8:00PM

Isafjordur, the largest town in the Westfjords peninsula, is known for its breathtaking landscapes. Here guests can enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities from biking, hiking, kayaking and horseback riding to whale watching. They can explore the history of the town that started as a trading post in the 16th century with growth triggered in the 19th century by salt fish production which is still the most important industry for the town.
