REGISTER FOR JUMP START ORIENTATION

To log into the Concordia Connect portal ([connect.CUChicago.edu](https://connect.cuchicago.edu)), use the personal username and password provided in your acceptance packet. The registration link is found on the Admit-Jump Start tab of the Concordia Connect portal.

REQUEST OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Whether you are a first-year or transfer student, please make sure to request your official final transcript from your previous educational institution, if not already submitted, including transcripts from any college attended for Dual Credit. If applicable, provide any results from AP, IB or CLEP tests. These documents should be sent to Concordia University Chicago's **Office of Undergraduate Admission**, utilizing the CUC recipient code 1140.

SUBMIT YOUR \$200 HOUSING DEPOSIT

Residential students, it's important to secure your housing for the upcoming academic year. To do so, please submit a \$200 housing deposit to the Office of Residence Life and Housing and complete a **Housing Application** at [connect.CUChicago.edu](https://connect.cuchicago.edu).

COMPLETE SKILL ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS

ALEKS Math Placement Exam: This exam is mandatory for freshman students who require a math course. For transfer students, it becomes mandatory if we have not received passing AP scores or transfer credit information before Jump Start. Prep materials can be found on the Concordia Connect portal. While proctored exams can be taken either online or on campus, please note that the online option is only accessible until one week before Jump Start. Beyond that point, testing must be completed during orientation.

To take the ALEKS Math Placement proctored exam before Jump Start you must register online: Sign into the Concordia Connect portal. Go to the "ALEKS Math Placement" block on the Admit-Jump Start tab. Then select the "Register for the Proctored Exam" link.

English Directed Self-Placement Questionnaire (DSP):

New traditional undergraduate students must complete this to determine their first-year English composition course. Access it online through Concordia Connect.

To take the English DSP online: Sign into the Concordia Connect portal. Go to the "Take Directed English Self-Placement Questionnaire" block on the Admit-Jump Start tab.

TASKS FOR NCAA STUDENT ATHLETES

Review eligibility requirements, complete NCAA registration and ATS paperwork by July 15 for fall sports, and by August 1 for all other sports. **Access the document at [CUCougars.com/checklist](https://cucougars.com/checklist)**

ATTEND THE JUMP START ORIENTATION PROGRAM

During orientation, you'll have the opportunity to meet with **Financial Aid** and **Student Business Services** to discuss your payment arrangements. Family is encouraged to join you.

PREPARE YOUR FALL COURSE SCHEDULE

Freshman students: Your academic advisor, as part of the Jump Start program, will be reviewing this with you.

Transfer students: Before Jump Start, we recommend evaluating your transfer credits and collaborating closely with your academic advisor to create your fall schedule.

SUBMIT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS
