Students, Faculty and Staff -

Concordia University Chicago has released full details of its Fall 2022 campus operations via the <u>University's COVID-19 website</u>. All employees and students are expected to familiarize themselves with current COVID-19 protocols, which they will be required to follow.

## **Highlights**

- Facemasks are NOT REQUIRED to be worn indoors, mirroring current state and county guidelines.
- Individuals may still wear facemasks should they choose to do so, and the University recommends all members of our campus community continue exhibiting understanding and kindness in this situation.
- The University will NOT require a negative COVID-19 test as a condition of returning to campus for the Fall 2022 semester.
- The State of Illinois COVID-19 vaccination mandate for students, faculty and staff expired on July 24, 2022; the University will NOT require COVID-19 vaccination for students, faculty or staff, and will not collect vaccination status documentation for the Fall 2022 semester.
- The University requires formal reporting for all individuals who have a confirmed case of COVID-19, have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 or have an assumed case of COVID-19.
- Individuals who are experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or who have been exposed to a positive case should complete testing at home or via an off-campus provider.
- The University will not offer on-campus COVID-19 testing.
- University events and extracurriculars are being held without capacity restrictions.
- All campus buildings and facilities are open general public.
